History

Primeros Pasos, Inc. was founded by a grass roots group of caring citizens who saw a need for a high-quality bilingual education and child care center in the Georgetown, DE area. The group opened such a center in 1997 and a second one in 1999. Eventually, both of these - located in rental properties - were closed.

Primeros Pasos was determined to offer its services in self-owned facilities, and in 2007 purchased a parcel of land on Savannah Road in Georgetown. Planning and fundraising for a permanent facility was initiated. For over ten years while raising funds for its expansion, Primeros Pasos provided services for twenty children a day aided by a generous offer of classroom space from St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Georgetown.

Finally, in April 2017, after receiving gifts and grants from over 200 individuals, foundations, churches and governmental agencies, Primeros Pasos was able to complete Phase 1 of its plan and moved into a 4,000 square foot, state-of-the-art early learning center on its Savannah Road property. The center is licensed for up to 45 children ages 12 weeks to 12 years.

The Future

In keeping with its efforts to meet the educational needs of as many children and their families as possible, Primeros Pasos has developed a Phase 2 plan which includes an addition which will increase its capacity to serve up to 75 children. .

Need

Primeros Pasos meets the needs of children and their families in Sussex County by providing the following:

- ◆ Early, bilingual education
- ◆ Increased capacity for affordable, quality child care
- ◆ Education for parents in child development and parenting skills
- ◆ Services for working families with limited support systems

Delaware Stars for Early Success

Primeros Pasos is a participant in Delaware Stars for Early Success, a program initiated by the Delaware Institute for Excellence in Early Childhood to ensure that all children enter school and are ready to succeed.

Services

Primeros Pasos provides bilingual early child care & education to children ages 12 weeks through 12 years. Classes include: nursery, toddler, 3, 4 and 5 year old, and before and after school. Parents are encouraged to participate in training sessions on parenting skills, health, education, nutrition, socialization and community resources.



Center Activities - Primeros Pasos teachers use lessons and materials from the Creative Curriculum. This curriculum emphasizes age-appropriate communication, social, intellectual and physical development which prepares children for successful participation in regular school classes and develops the foundation to become responsible citizens.



Staffing - Primeros Pasos staff members meet Delaware childcare licensing criteria. Our staff includes teachers who are bilingual and trained to provide a culturally sensitive environment and positive interaction with all children and their parents. The Primeros Pasos Teacher/Student ratios meet the exceptionally high standards of STARS for Early Success, which gives teachers more time with all children.
